



Initial Training for Air Traffic Controllers

Aviation English Course

General

This course complies with ICAO linguistic requirements.

Course Objectives

The aim of this course is to impart skills and knowledge to speak English in an intelligible way, understandable for the international community. Instruction will cover pronunciation, grammatical structures, vocabulary, fluency, comprehension and interaction and will qualify for at least level 4 of the ICAO language proficiency table.

Content

The content is based on aviation literature to communicate with accuracy and clarity. Grammatical structures and sentence patterns are trained and sufficient vocabulary range is included for effective communication. The course includes specific ATM vocabulary and communication is trained with the aim of immediate, appropriate, and informative responses.

Entry requirements

The students shall be fluent and be able to express him/herself without too many problems regarding accuracy and appropriate vocabulary shall be used. In more advanced areas of the language the student may still be uncertain in the proper application of vocabulary and grammar. Pronunciation shall be reasonable to a degree, that listeners may occasionally have problems

understanding but not to the detriment of the subject being discussed.

Selected student ATCOs which have successfully passed a CCC Basic Course.

Assessment and Certificate

The students learning progress will be continuously assessed and subject to regular feedback procedures. Written and oral examinations are designed to assess the proficiency items as laid down in the ICAO Annex I

The main focus of instruction is on interactive communicative skills training in form of discussions, role plays and student presentations.
