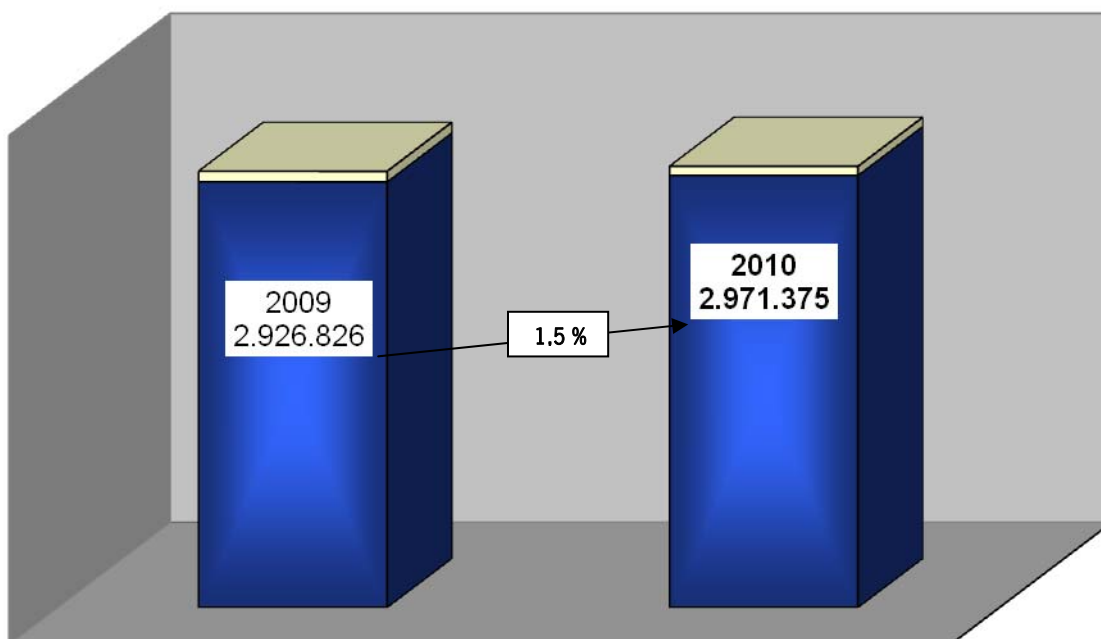

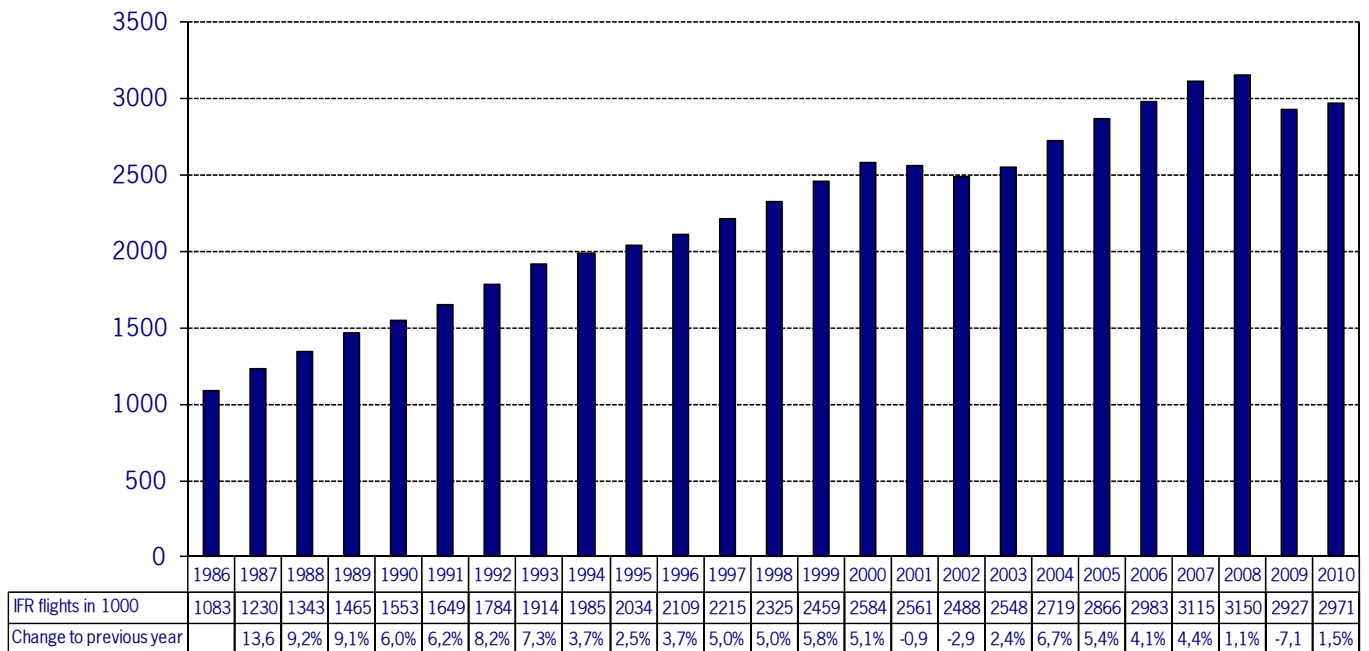
IFR flights in the Federal Republic of Germany

Peak Day 24.09.2010 – 10.057 IFR flights

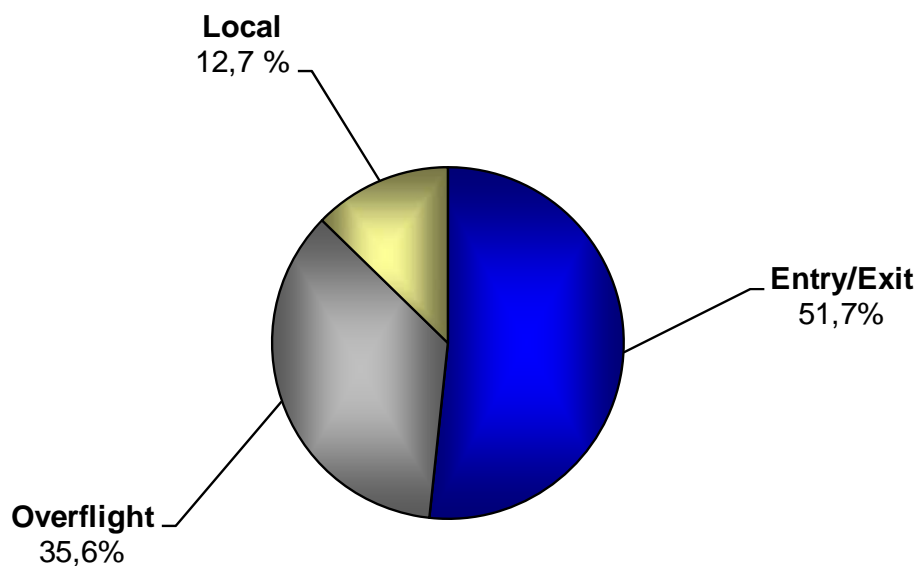

Entries, exits, overflights and domestic flights in 2010

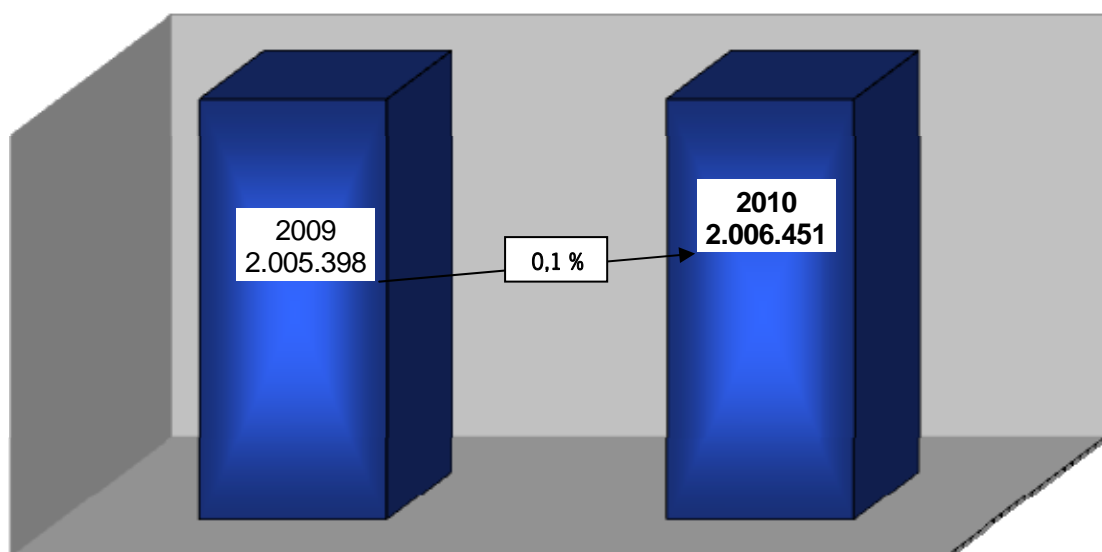

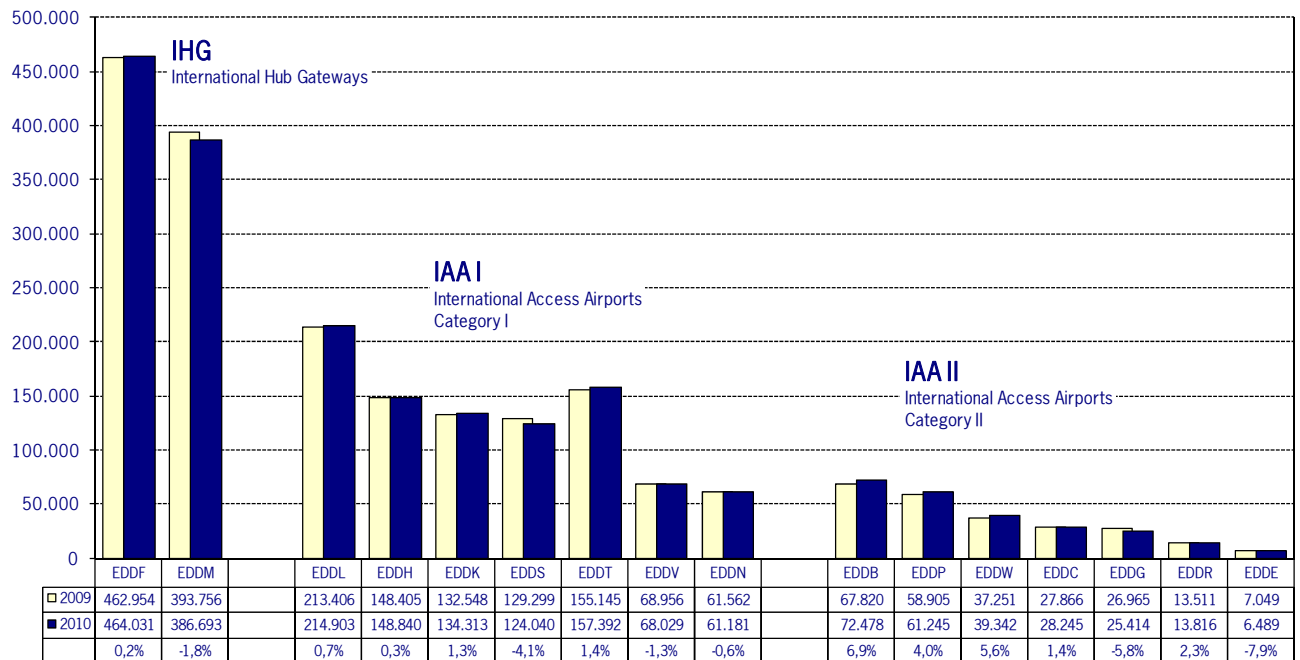

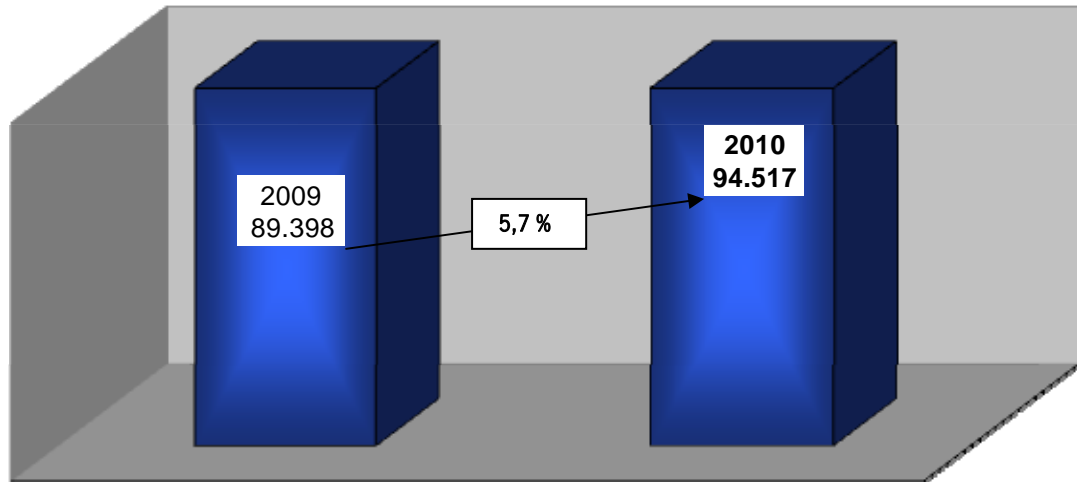

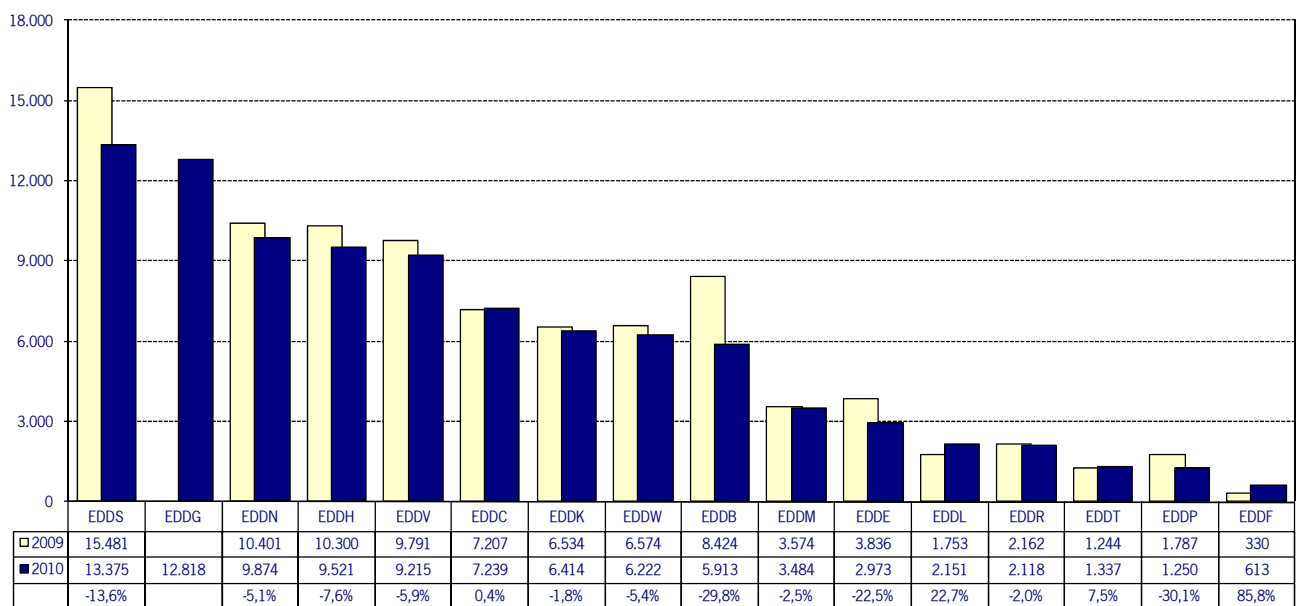

Traffic count of VFR take-offs, landings and touch & goes at international airports

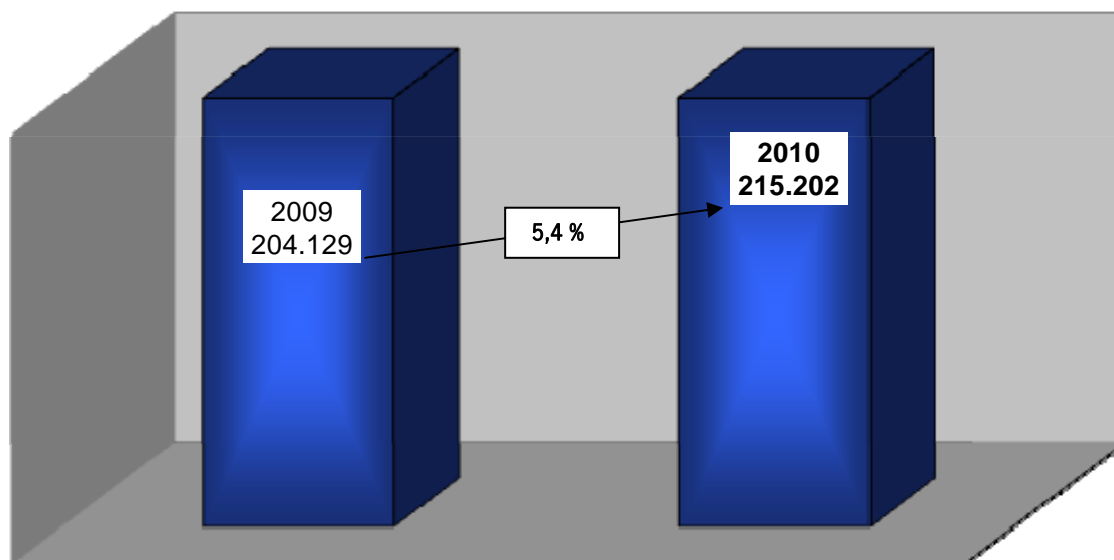

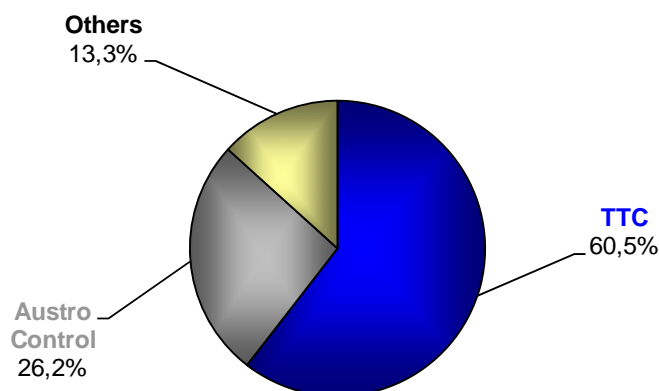
